

Library Bookmark Art Contest

GUIDELINES

1. Children, teens, and adults are eligible to participate.
2. Entries will be accepted at any Tuscarawas County Public Library location during normal business hours. Entries must be submitted by 5:00 PM on Friday, August 1st. No late entries will be accepted.
3. Artwork can be in any medium—computer art, photography, crayon, watercolor, marker, oil, acrylic, pencil, etc., but should be one-dimensional for printing purposes. **Artwork should be created and submitted as printed artwork that is 2" x 8"**. All entries must be submitted with a completed entry form. No AI artwork permitted.
4. Entries will be judged on how well they convey the important role a library plays in society and, especially, how libraries "Color Our World."
5. Artwork will be judged by a three-person panel including a professional artist, a library staff member, and a community member. Decisions by the judges are final.
6. Children and grandchildren of Tuscarawas County Public Library employees are eligible to enter the contest; however, their parents, grandparents, or caregivers are not eligible to be judges.
7. Winners will be announced during the Library Card Sign-up Month in September.
8. The winning design will be featured on limited edition library bookmark(s) until the supply is exhausted.
9. Entries may be picked up at the Main Library (121 Fair Ave. NW in New Philadelphia) between September 8th through September 20th. The library is not responsible for entries left at the Library after Monday, September 22nd.
10. **Artwork and entry forms must be turned in at a Tuscarawas County Public Library location no later than 5:00 PM on Friday, August 1st. Entries sent through the mail or dropped in the bookdrops will not be accepted. Absolutely no late entries will be accepted.**
